



Math 7 Syllabus

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Course Description:

The students will gain a thorough understanding of the Math 7 Georgia Standards of Excellence.

Texts:

Students are provided with a Volume I and Volume II interactive, write-in textbook. If the textbook is lost or damaged, the replacement cost is \$10 per volume. Online materials from McGraw-Hill are also available:

Materials:

Students will be required to have paper, pencil, Math Survival Guide (MSG) and pen daily in class. Some other items that may be needed are: graph paper, calculator, glue stick, expo markers and device for BYOD activities.

Make-Up Expectations:

Students will have the same number of days to make up any missed assignment as the number of days absent. Students should check the class blog each day that they are absent. In addition, students should check the "Missed Assignments" crate for any handouts. Any classwork turned in one day late will receive a maximum grade of 80%; turned in two days late will receive a grade of 50%; work will not be accepted more than two days late.

**Exceptions will be made for excused absences.*

Reassessment (Do Over) Policy:

Students scoring below 74% on a unit test will be given the opportunity to participate in grade recovery. They will be required to complete a remediation assignment and come in early to take the revised assessment. The grade on the new assessment will replace the original grade but shall not exceed 74%.

BYOD (Bring Your Own Device):

We will be implementing "BYOD" in the classroom this year. Students will be required to register their device and obtain parental permission to participate in the BYOD implementation. Digital citizenship is a key component of the program, and students will be released from the program for failure to adhere to the guidelines.
